

GENERAL REGULATIONS OF CAMS

Organising Permits

An Organising Permit is issued by CAMS in accordance with the NCR (refer Part IV, National Competition Rules (NCR) of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport).

At its discretion CAMS may issue, withhold or withdraw an Organising Permit. In considering any application for an Organising Permit, CAMS may have regard to criteria including the following:

- (i) the CAMS motor sport calendar policy;
- (ii) the status of the proposed event;
- (iii) CAMS' international obligations;
- (iv) the impact on the public and the public interest;
- (v) the impact on competitors and officials and their respective interests;
- (vi) commercial arrangements; and
- (vii) any other factor considered relevant in the circumstances.

The allocation of a permit number by CAMS does not indicate that an organising permit will be issued.
